

Popcorn Machine



How to Operate

1. First, find a flat surface near an electrical outlet before starting. Make sure your cord is away from any water source. It is acceptable to use an extension cord if needed.
2. Gather your popcorn making supplies: popcorn, seasoning, bowls or bags for holding the popcorn, cooking oil, and popcorn scooper.
3. Plug in machine while switch is flipped to OFF position.
4. Make sure Kettle is properly secured in support brackets.
5. Make sure Kettle motor is plugged in.
6. Turn appliance ON by flipping the switch on the top of the machine. Allow the machine to run 3-5 minutes to heat up kettle.
7. Turn unit OFF.
8. Using the provided Oven Mitt open the flap on the Kettle and then use the Measuring Spoon supplied to add 1 tablespoon of Popcorn Cooking Oil. ***Caution – Kettle will be HOT***
9. Add popcorn kernels to the Kettle using supplied measuring cup. *Always follow this rule: 1 Tablespoon oil + 2-oz popcorn = 8 cups popcorn* **(DO NOT exceed 2.5oz of popcorn kernels)***
10. Turn the unit ON and close the door. In no time at all, you will hear the popping begin. Fresh, hot popcorn will begin to burst out of the flip lids on the Kettle – just like at the theater!
11. Use your popcorn Scoop to scoop and serve.
